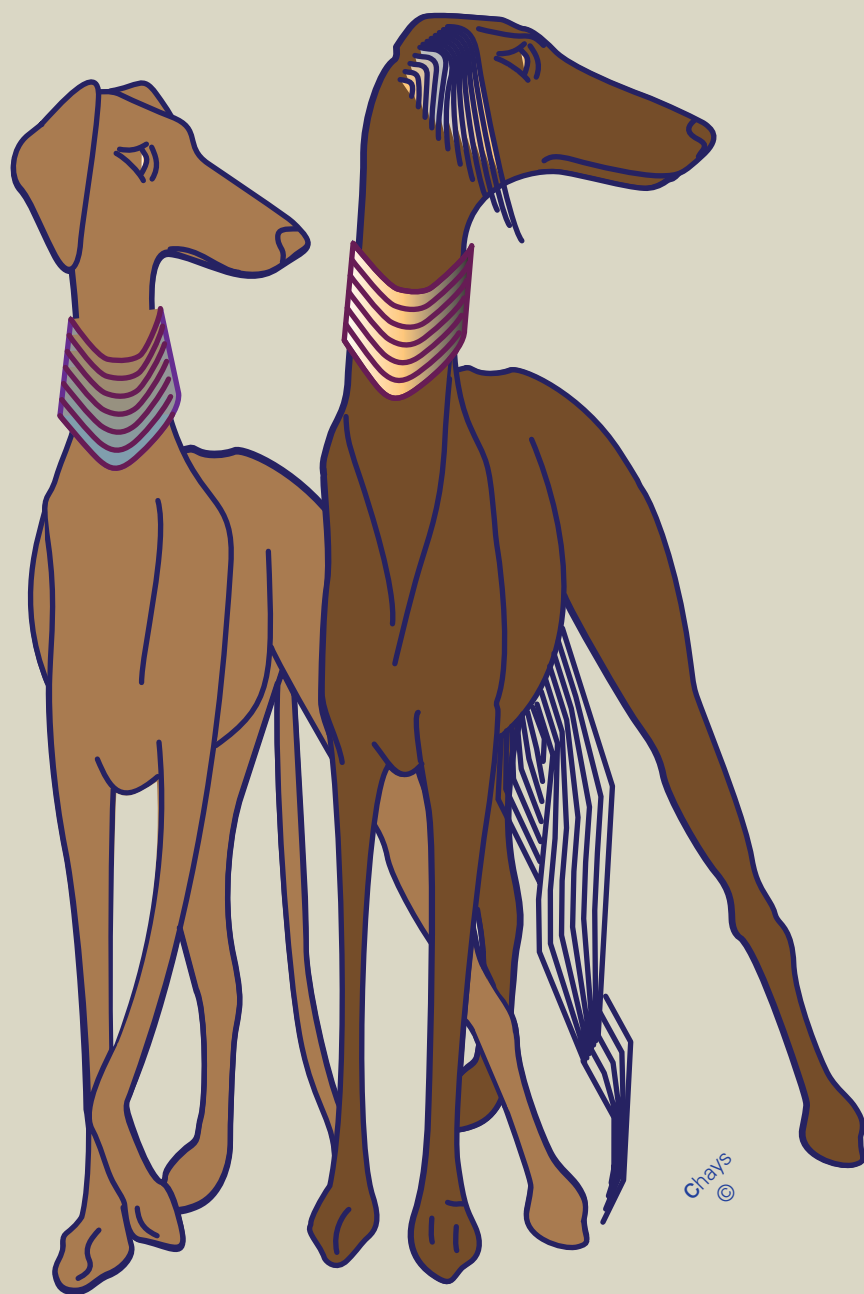

- Anyone who exhibited a Saluki in a CKC event in the calendar year of the issue and wishes to advertise that win.

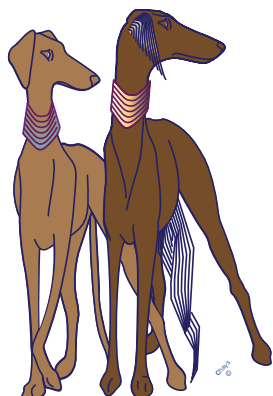
Pages in the magazine

CKC BREED STANDARD FOR THE SALUKI

Origin and Purpose: The Saluki is one of the oldest known breeds of dogs. It has existed, virtually unchanged, for many thousands of years. It was originally bred by the Arab tribesmen for bringing down game, and was considered a sacred gift of god by the tribesmen. In Arabic, an ordinary dog is called kelb, while the Saluki is El Hor, The Noble one.

General Appearance: The whole appearance of this breed should give an impression of grace and symmetry and of great speed and endurance coupled with strength and activity to enable it to kill a gazelle or other quarry over deep sand or rocky mountains.

The expression should be dignified and gentle with deep, faithful, far-seeing eyes.

Size: Dogs should average in height from 23 to 28 inches (58 to 71 cm), and bitches may be considerably smaller, this being very typical of the breed.

Coat: Smooth and of a soft silky texture, slight feather on the legs, feather at the back of the thighs and sometimes with slight wooly feather on the thigh and shoulder.

Colour: White, cream, fawn, golden, red, grizzle, and tan tricolour (white, black and tan), black and tan, or any of the aforementioned colours and white.

Head: Long and narrow, skull moderately wide between the ears, not domed, stop not pronounced, the whole showing great quality. Nose black or liver; teeth strong and level; eyes dark to hazel and bright; large and oval, but not prominent; ears long and covered with long silky hair hanging close to the skull and mobile.

Neck: Long, supple, and well muscled.

Forequarters: Shoulders sloping and set well back, well muscled without being coarse. Forelegs straight and long from the elbow to the knee.

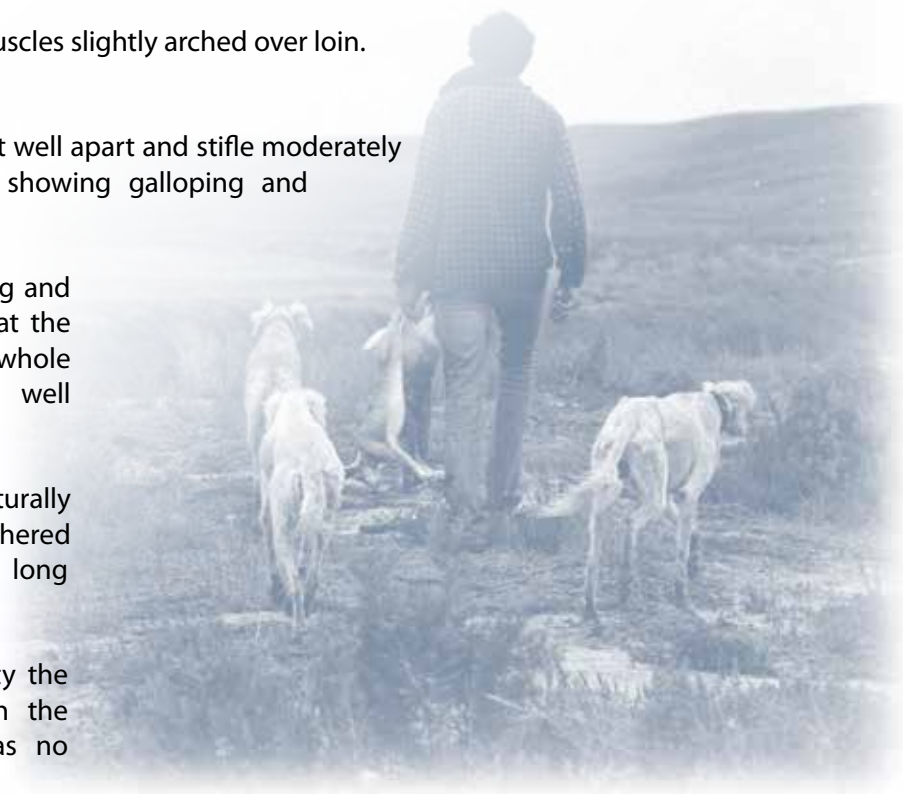
Loin and Back: Back fairly broad, muscles slightly arched over loin. Chest deep and moderately narrow.

Hindquarters: Strong, hip bones set well apart and stifle moderately bent, hocks low to the ground, showing galloping and jumping power.

Feet: Of moderate length, toes long and well arched, not splayed out, but at the same time not cat-footed: the whole being strong and supple and well feathered between the toes.

Tail: Long, set on low and carried naturally in a curve, well feathered on the underside with long silky hair, not bushy.

The Smooth Variety: In this variety the points should be the same with the exception of the coat, which has no feathering.

FLORENCE AMHERST ON ORIENTAL GREYHOUNDS

Brian Patrick Duggan

“It should be the object of all those who import the Greyhounds of the East, and breed them in this country, to try to keep distinct the different varieties, which in many cases have been so carefully preserved in their own lands. The historic interest attached to each breed is alone a sufficient inducement to do so.”

Florence Amherst, 1907*

ORIENTAL GREYHOUNDS

- I. Slughy, Tazi, or Gazelle hound
- II. Ahk-Taz-eet or Kirghiz Greyhound
- III. The North African Slughy, or Slughy of the Sahara
- IV. The Barukhzy Hound, or Afghan Greyhound
- V. The Rampur Hound, or Greyhound of Northern India
- VI. The Poligar hound, or Greyhound of Southern India

By 1907, The Honourable Florence Margaret Tyssen Amherst was a recognized authority on Oriental Greyhounds who identified seven distinct types. She specified four different classes of Salukis (Type I)—largely based on their amount of feathering and point of geographic origin. At that time, Amherst called them “Slughis,” based on colloquial information from correspondents in Egypt, Arabia, Mesopotamia, and Persia. After further study of classical Arabic literature, she came to believe that “Saluki” (from the formal Arabic) was the correct term and could be modified by the feathering/geographic descriptor *Shami*, *Yamani*, *Omani*, or *Nejdi*. Amherst’s preference was for the Saluki *Shami*—the most feathered “breed” as she called them. The *Yamani* and *Omani* had respectively less feathering but the *Nejdi* was smooth coated and as far as I know, not seen in England until after WWI. When Amherst published the first breed standard in Robert Leighton’s *The New Book of the Dog* (1907),[†] it was written expressly for her Saluki *Shami*, however she later helped write the breed standard of 1923 which did allow the smooth coat.

What we now call the Sloughy, she called, “the North African Slughy or Saharan Slughy.” Amherst believed these were once related to smooth Salukis but had become a distinct type. As such, she never endorsed the breeding of a Saluki with a Sloughy, or indeed, any of the other Oriental Greyhound types she’d named. She refused to breed her Salukis with Tazis (Persian Greyhounds)—even though they looked very much like her Amherstias—as they were the wrong taxonomical type. It is worth noting that she repeatedly rejected requests to mate her Amherstias with English Greyhounds for the purpose of toughening up the latter’s feet for coursing and infusing them with more stamina. Amherst was adamant on this point so Greyhound breeders experimented cross-breeding with other Oriental Greyhounds.

Her caution against mixing the “different varieties [types]” was a preservationist’s reaction to a more relaxed attitude towards breeding at that time. In those days, it was common enough for this sort of conversation to occur over a pint ...

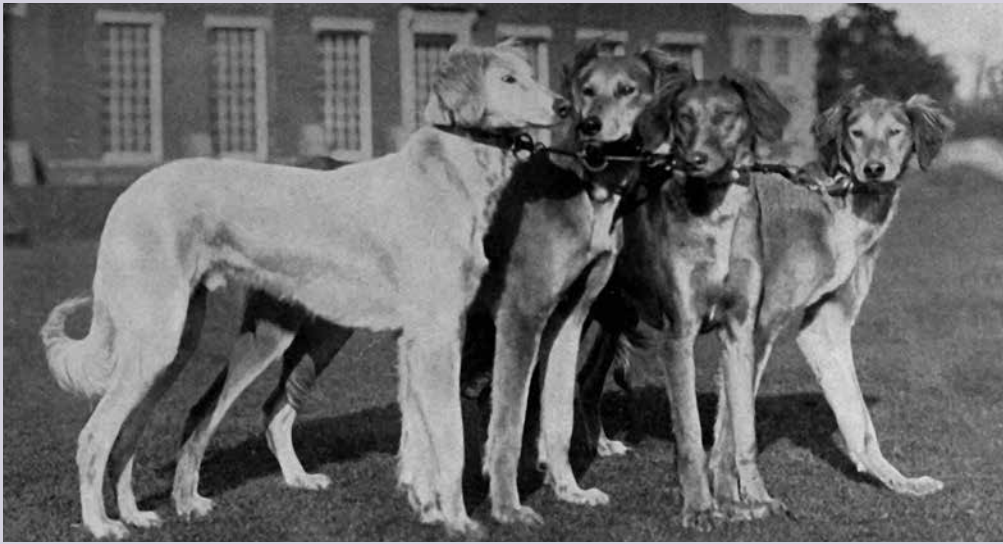
Hey, you’ve got a dog from the Middle East! Me too. Not too many of us around eh? They kind of look alike—what do you say we breed them and have a litter?

Amherst would have none of this sort of intermingling, but she would breed to a type that matched her Amherstia look. Her first Salukis came directly from Egypt, there was a brief influx from the Transjordan and, lastly, she incorporated southern Iraqi Salukis into her line. While she never bred an Amherstia bitch outside of her kennel, Florence Amherst did not hesitate to let her males be used at public stud—notably the kennels of her friends, Brigadier and Mrs. Gladys Lance (Sarona) and Miss Francis Joan Mitchell (Nablous), who each had begun with their own imported desert stock.

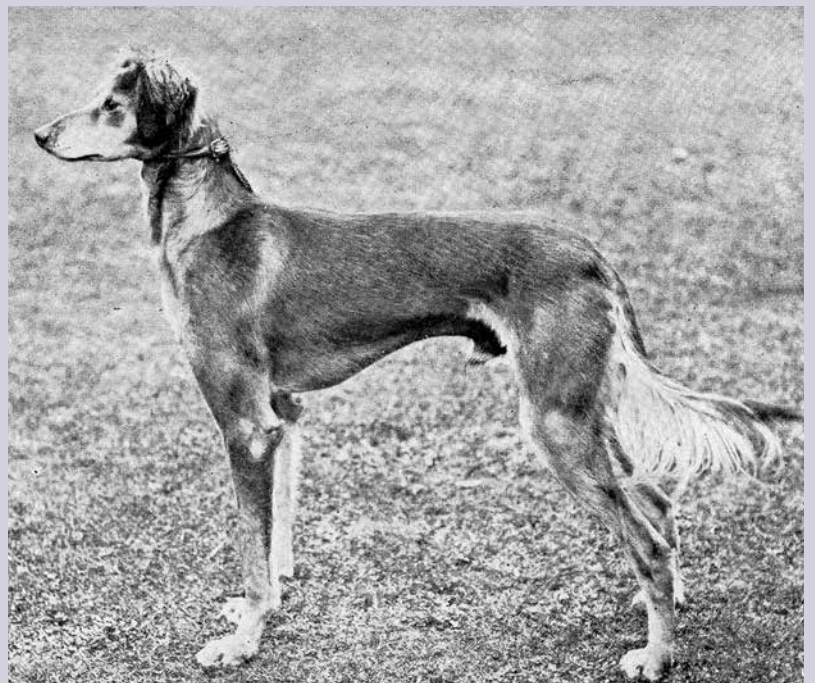

SALLY ANNE THOMPSON

THANKS FOR THE MEMORIES

For those of us who became involved with Salukis back in the sixties and seventies, especially if we lived in places like Canada, with its vast distances and tiny Saluki population, the photographs of Sally Anne Thompson played an important role in our discovery and ultimate appreciation of the breed. We had little opportunity to see many Salukis in the flesh. We had to depend on photographs, and that wasn't easy either, since there were few books or magazines devoted to the breed and the internet hadn't yet come on the scene. Many of the images we saw became indelibly printed in our minds, and of those more than a few came from the camera of Sally Anne Thompson.

These weren't Salukis standing in boring and stilted show ring poses. Some were portraits, but they were portraits of character and strength, or Saluki faces caught in quirky moments of time. Others were Salukis in nature, simply enjoying themselves on the beach or rocketing down a hillside. Some were in colour; most were in black and white—or at least we saw them in black and white, because back then colour printing was too expensive for magazines and books to offer many colour photographs.

While we Saluki folk may know her mostly from her Saluki images, Sally Anne Thompson is of course a world renowned photographer of all animals. But it was in fact Salukis that brought her into the animal photography field. Her father was a fashion photographer, and Sally Anne seemed

destined to follow in his footsteps, until one day the studio was asked for some dog pictures. As Sally's husband, Ron Willbie, recounts, "Sally was asked to go as an assistant to the photographer who was doing the job. She took some happy snaps whilst there and Vera Watkins, whose Windswift Salukis were photographed, was very pleased with them, telling Sally she 'had the touch' and strongly encouraged her to take up dog photography. The rest is history."

Photographing animals had always been her passion, but she jumped at the chance to make it her life's work and quickly gained a reputation as one of the best in the field. In 1962 she was commissioned by the publishers of an illustrated dog book, *Champion Dogs of the World*, to travel across Europe and America photographing dogs chosen as the best representatives of their breeds. The book was a huge critical and popular success,

and was followed by *The World's Finest Horses and Ponies* and *Champion Cats of the World*, for which she also did the photographs. In 1989 the first of her own books, *Photographing Dogs*, came out to acclaim.

Her images, from a career spanning more than 50 years, are recognized and admired around the world. We are delighted to have received permission to feature a few of them here.

She and husband Ron, also a skilled photographer, live on the Isle of Wight, with two rescued greyhounds.

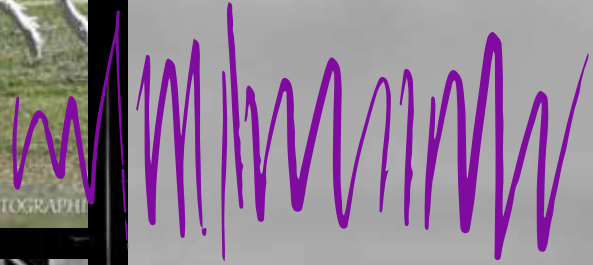

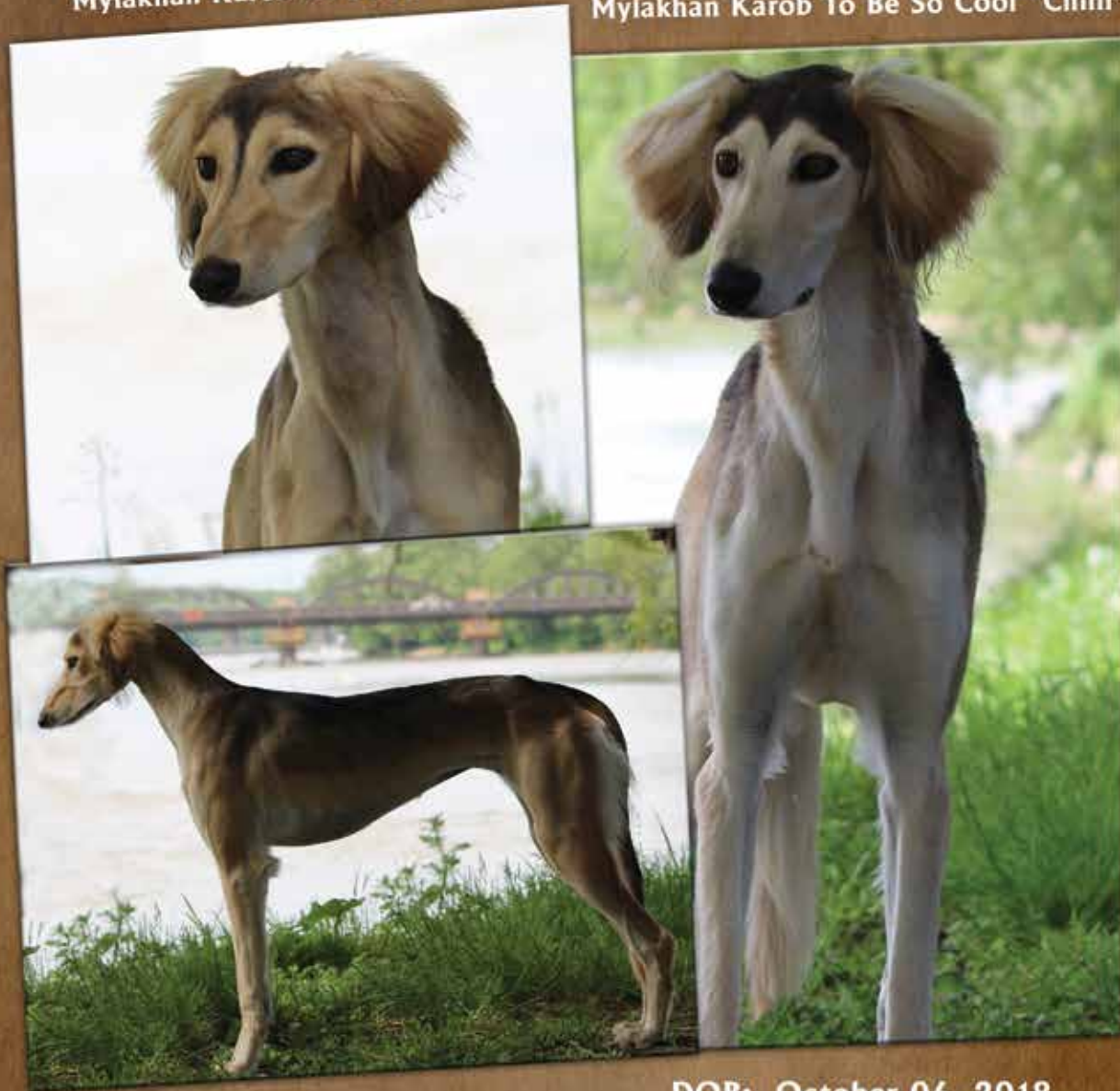

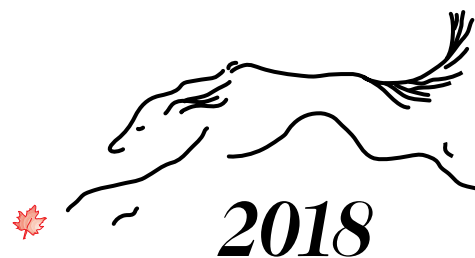

JUDGE'S GENERAL COMMENTS

Many of the exhibits were still young, and although Salukis and other breeds can become Show Champions in Canada already at a very early age (six months?), a Saluki is not fully developed until much later.

In Sweden, a young Saluki may be awarded CACs (our "points") in the Junior class from nine months of age, but these awards do not qualify for a Champion title until the dog has reached the age of two years and one day when the qualifying CAC is awarded. (You need at least three CACs to become a National Champion, from at least two different judges.)

After having fulfilled my appointment on the Saturday, I managed to see many of "my" Salukis being judged again, by other judges in other rings, at other shows held in the same place - which was an instant reminder of that the same exhibits don't always look or behave the same, only a short period after having been judged by me, at the same place, the same day!

The Salukis shown to me all had friendly and typical temperaments. One or two were perhaps a little too playful in the ring, and some were not entirely happy to be there that day.

There was, as desired, a variation of types, colours and coats, all within the breed standard.

Many of the exhibits carried their heads rather low on the move, which I'm not used to see in my part of the world nowadays. A Saluki should of course not carry its head like an Afghan hound or a Poodle, but a low carriage detracts from the typical elegance and proud dignity of the breed.

Thank you very much to those of you having nominated and voted for me to judge at your National 2018. I and my travel companion and friend Elisabet Levén (Afghan Hound owner and successful exhibitor) were very well taken care of during our stay in Winnipeg and we really enjoyed the friendly atmosphere and hospitality. Thank you to our "chauffeurs" who took us to and from

the show area (Rosemary Young on the Friday, and Debbie on the Saturday).

I had an excellent ring steward, Lorna Muir. The ring was beautifully decorated and lovely rosettes were awarded to the winners. The home cooked lunch and pastry added to the enjoyments.

A special thank you to the Club for the lovely dinner after the shows, with many nice words and friendly laughs.

Elisabet and I are also very grateful to the three ladies Nancy Kovall, Candace Cook and Corinne Walker for taking us around in Manitoba on the Monday (Nancy and Candace) and Tuesday (Corinne), after the shows. We visited Winnipeg City Centre, and the Manitoba Legislative Building. We attended a guided tour at the Royal Canadian Mint. 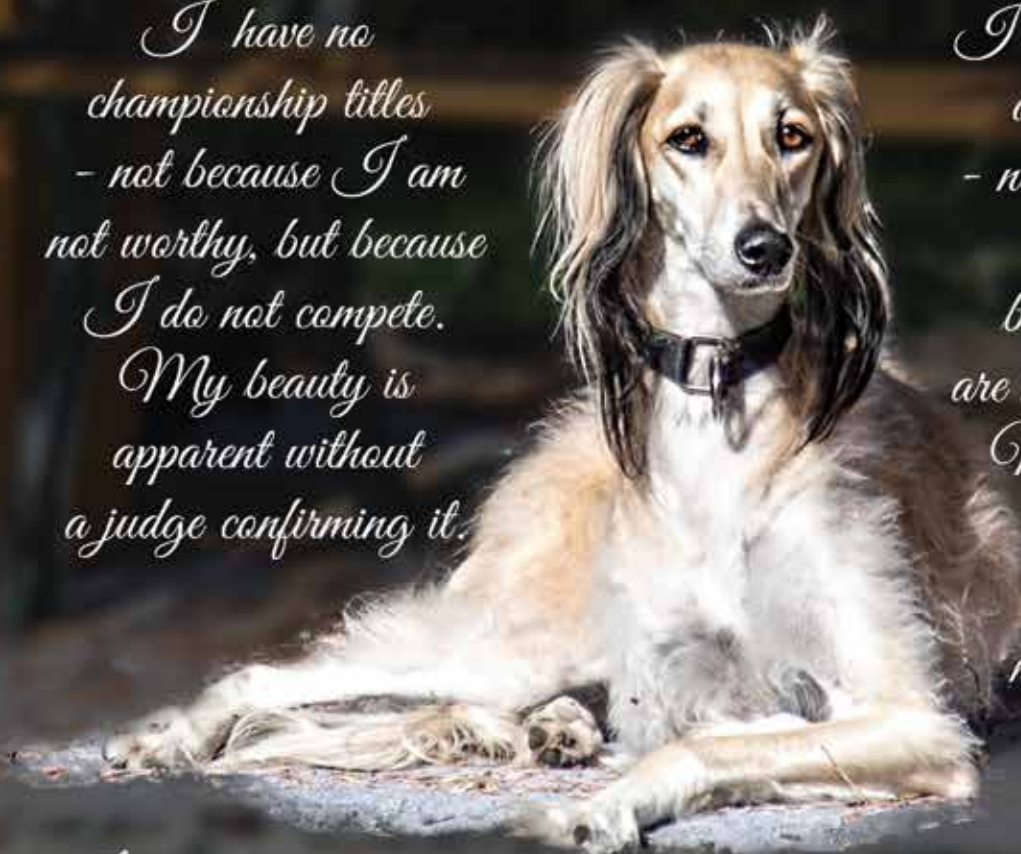

It always comes as a shock when we hear of Salukis in need of rescue, and when the dogs in question belong to someone well known not only to the Saluki community but also prominent on the Canadian purebred dog scene, the shock is even greater. Such was the case in 2015 when it was learned that the dogs of Alan Ewles had been seized by the Oakville/Milton Humane Society, and later that he had been charged and found guilty under the OSPCA Act. These events happened before the Saluki Annual came on

the scene but when Trish Taylor submitted her moving account of elderly adoptee Zoe's hair-raising adventure, which happened shortly after she arrived to live with Trish, it seemed that an accompanying update on the fate of the rest of the sixteen Salukis might be in order.

Thanks go to Patty Milton, Janice Preiss and Trish for providing the update. Thank you also to the many people who opened their hearts and their homes to these dogs who were in such desperate need of help.

FINDING ZOE

This is the story of finding and finally catching 12 year old Zoe, 10 days after she slipped out my gate and made her way over onto the forested trail system along the river behind my house. She had recently come into my care and my heart via OMHS from the SPCA raid and seizure of the Afking Salukis.

That hot, humid day, I was searching in an area where I'd seen Zoe the day before. I had just changed out the card on the trail camera and circled around onto an unfamiliar trail, when

I inadvertently trapped her (so I thought) in a broken down lean-to type shelter. As I came down the only (and very narrow) path leading to it, there she was, standing frozen in the right hand side, fear in her eyes, ready to flee. I gasped out loud when I saw her there. I was about 25 feet away and I very slowly sat down on a big downed tree.

First I calmed myself, then started trying to get her to relax. I tossed bits of food to her and she was very hungry but would eat only what landed right at her feet. After close to an hour she finally lay down



and I was able to quietly move a few feet closer along the tree. I sat there for a bit, wondering how long it would be before it was safe to move again and eyeing her shelter to determine the safest way to get her without her injuring herself if she were to panic. Suddenly she stood up and rushed out a side opening which I couldn't see from my angle. And just like that she disappeared back into the woods.

As you can imagine, I felt ill. I waited there for nearly half an hour but she didn't reappear, so I left a bit of food for her and started to head back the way I came. Quite a way down the path, I rounded a bend and startled her coming towards me, just a few feet away, as if she were returning to the lean-to. She really took off that time.

Armed with that info, I called Laura McKibbin Caron (Healing Hearts Lost Pet Search) and Maureen Häni, and they rounded up Andrea Barker from Oakville Milton HS (one of Zoe's first care givers). Laura and Andrea headed to Brantford. While I waited to meet them, there was a torrential downpour, the second half of a big thunderstorm moving through, and I was soaked right through. Soon we were headed back down the stinging-nettle-lined trails, with provisions for a trap and a roll of plastic snow fence. Thankfully by then the rain had stopped. When I finally found the right trail, Andrea placed the snow fence loosely across it as a just-in-case deterrent. The plan was to assess the lean-to and decide where best to put the humane trap, and then go back to its current location and get it.

Laura went ahead on the narrow path and as we got close she spotted Zoe curled up, asleep in the lean-to! We all quietly backed away and they devised a plan to hand catch her. Laura crept up the left side to block the spot where Zoe had gotten out earlier. I backed up on the trail to be in position to get hold of her if she got past Andrea. I was stifling sobs at this stage I must say.

Andrea slowly approached her (by this time she was ready to bolt) and gave her a clear view of the only escape route. Zoe took the bait and tried to





race past Andrea, who got the snare pole across and caught her just in the nick of time. She quickly scooped her up and called out the good news! I hurried over, weak in the knees and nearly blinded by tears—the relief was so overwhelming. We were all crying. And even though she was still running till that very last moment, my poor Zoe was so exhausted that she hung limply in Andrea's arms.

We lugged the gear back out to the cars on foot with Andrea carrying the shell-shocked Zoe most of the way. She was very thin, full of burrs and in need of some serious rest, but **finally** safe.

I will never forget that day and I have **so** much gratitude for everyone who was involved in any way, from the worst-nightmare first evening, through the extremely stressful 10 days to the glorious ending. Besides the ladies mentioned, most notably Kim

Fountain, Paula Johnson, Christine Smith and her crew, and the many members [and good friends] from the Saluki Club of Canada who also came out to search, thank you all.

Trish Taylor

Trish (Patricia) Taylor has had Salukis for 43 years, from Windstorm, Sedeki and Khamsin. Trish is also a long-time Saluki Club of Canada member.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

In November 2015, the humane society contacted the Arabian Saluki Organization to assess 10 Salukis seized from Alan Ewles's kennel. Sixteen dogs in total had been seized in late summer. The cost the humane society incurred for attending to these dogs' many issues was exorbitant. While charges were still pending, the humane society negotiated with Mr. Ewles to release six dogs back into his 'care,' while the remaining 10 were surrendered to the humane society for adoption. Mr. Ewles chose to take all the young Salukis and walked away from his old dogs, many blind, infirm and ill-prepared to function outside his kennel environment, having never been socialized.

Thanks to new homes, the Salukis adopted through the humane society were blessed with the opportunity to live the life all dogs should have, surrounded by love and security. Gaining their trust was hard-fought but worth every minute. Here is an update on the dogs that were adopted through the humane society. [Note: All age references are the presumed age at the time of the rescue.]

Zoe and Gem – Trish Taylor opened her home to 11-year-old Zoe, who had touch and sound sensitivities, and 11-year-old Gem, who had vision issues. Both dogs also had pressure sores, skin infections, worms, parasites, rotten teeth and were extremely thin (even by sighthound standards). This was the case for all the rescued dogs. Trish's struggles and triumphs with Zoe are covered in the preceding article and were the impetus for this follow-up to the Afking rescue.

Lana and Toley – Both around six years old, Lana and Toley were adopted by Pauline Burdett. Toley was blind and "almost shut down" when he arrived at the humane society. Anxiety meds helped alleviate this, but his new home made him a new dog. In mid-2016, Pauline set up a Facebook page dedicated to "The Adventures of Lana and Toley." Check it out.

Diamond – At the time of the rescue, he was nine years old and in the late stages of kidney disease. Since he was not expected to live more than a year, the humane society chose to foster him. They also covered the cost of his medications and eventual euthanasia.

Storm – Believed to be around 10 years old, Storm moved to Thunder Bay to live with Mary Szabo and her Saluki crew. He was one of the healthier of the rescues, described as a "beautiful, fun and happy boy."

Andy – This 10-year-old Saluki was the only one that the humane society felt might appeal to a larger adoption base, since he wasn't as fearful as the other dogs. Fortunately he was adopted by a Saluki owner, Kim Fountain.

Dante – Another young dog around five years of age, he was the last to leave the humane society. He had trust issues and was kept isolated from the other dogs for months. He was finally fostered in spring 2016 by Saluki Club of Canada member Virginia Jones. He came out of his shell with Salukis Solo and Theo. It was a long process but he was eventually adopted in the spring of 2017.

Topaz – This six-year-old black and tan had a broken leg and was on the mend at the humane society. She was fostered during her rehabilitation and adopted by Ann Thomas.

Betsy – This eight year old sable female, a beautiful playful girl, was adopted by an employee of the OSPCA.

After Mr. Ewles' conviction, he was barred from ever owning any animal in the province of Ontario. The remaining six Salukis needed to be rehomed. Before the conviction, the dogs were placed in a boarding kennel run by a Yorkie breeder, but they were eventually split up. Here's what we know about the remaining six Salukis.

Ole and Pharo – The two young boys, both about six years old, were taken by Mr. Ewles to Norm Fargo and his partner Neil. After caring for the dogs for over a year and a half with no compensation and no communication with Mr. Ewles, Norm and Neil decided to keep them. They had fallen for the boys and felt strongly that they should be kept together. Both have been neutered and are enjoying a loving home and plenty of canine companionship.

Azelia – One of the youngest Salukis, just three years old, Azelia was temporarily living with a spaniel breeder. She unfortunately broke her leg and was taken to the vet for euthanasia. Vicki Ellery worked at this clinic and offered to take her, hoping her leg would mend and she would become a member of the family. After many unsuccessful surgeries and Azelia's inability to let go of her past demons, the painful decision was made to have her euthanized.

Chanel, Pharah and Phoebe – The remaining three bitches were the only ones that stayed with the Yorkie breeder. Chanel is Azelia's littermate and littermates Pharah and Phoebe were five years old at the time of rescue. Where they are now remains a mystery.

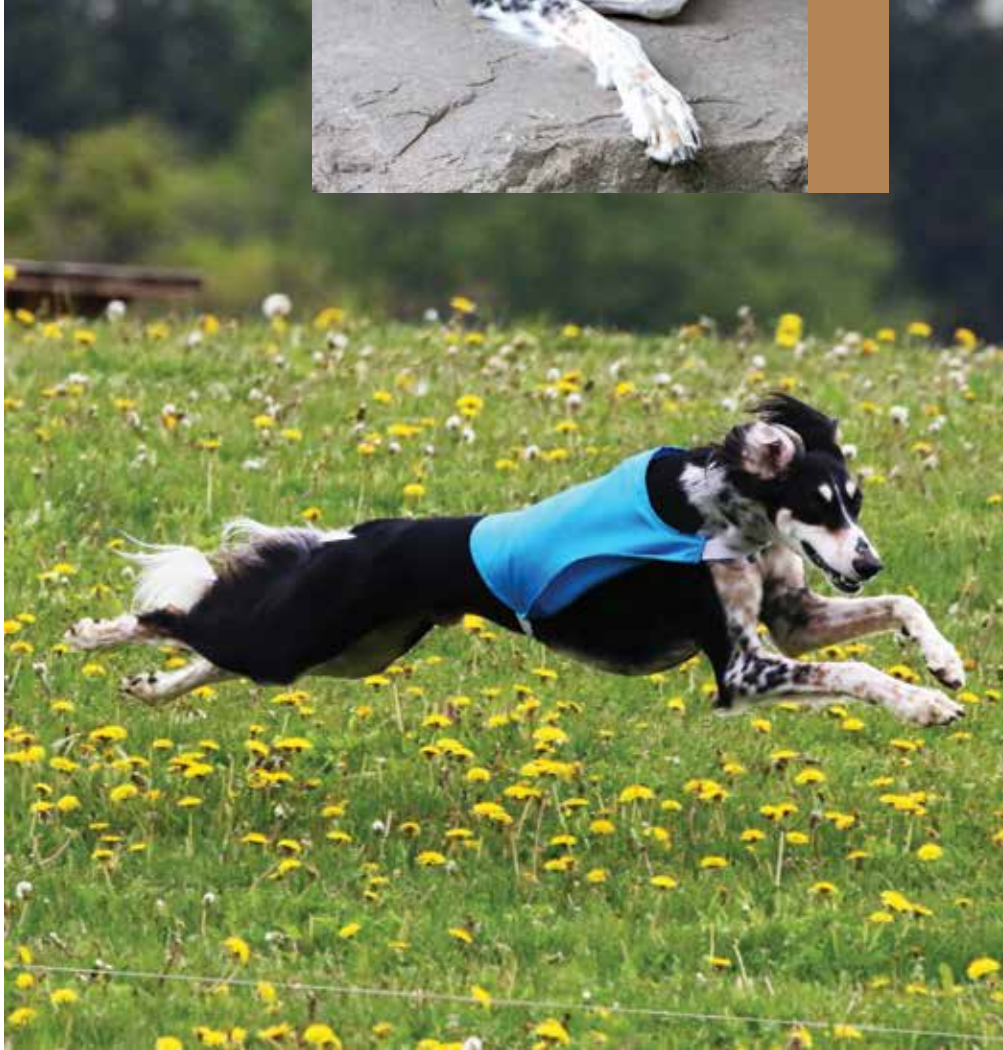

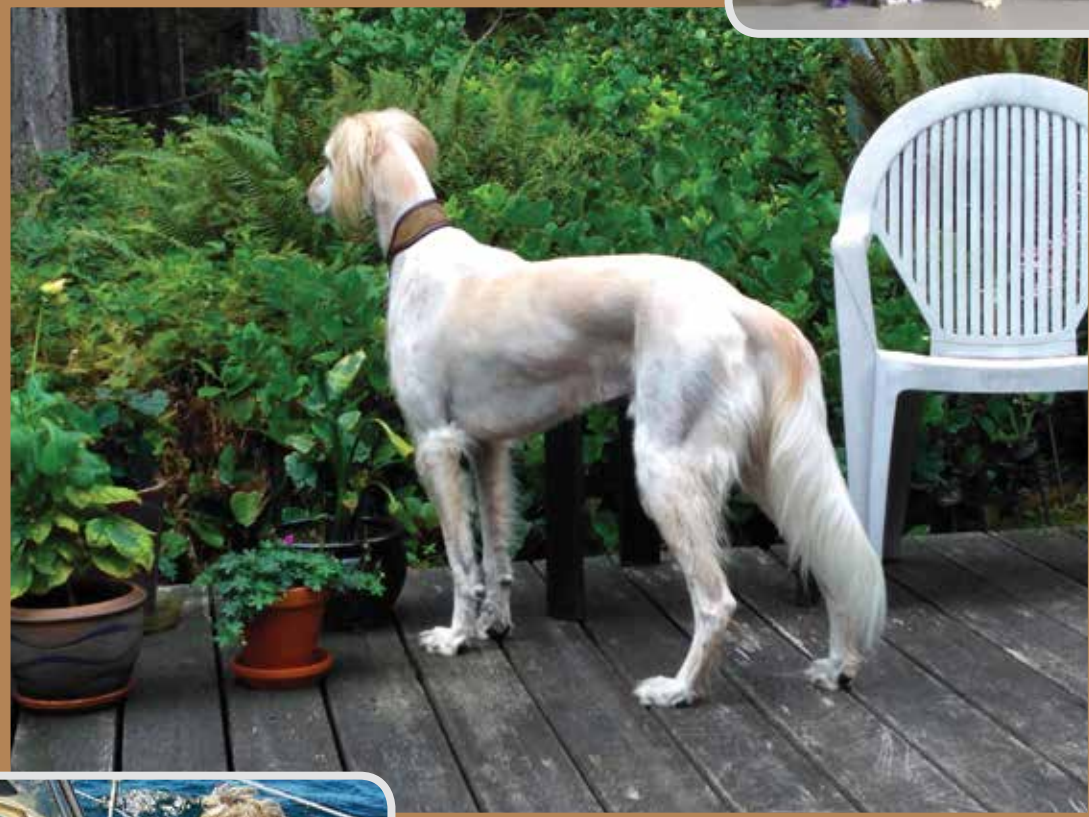
